VINTAGE CARS ON SHOW AT WHITEMAN PARK

Whether you're a car enthusiast or just love the nostalgia of vintage cars you won't want to miss the Classic Car Show at Whiteman Park this month.

The Classic Car Show will bring together more than a thousand lovingly restored vintage and classic cars from nearly 70 car clubs.

Presented by the Council of Motoring Clubs WA Inc, the show this year will feature seven classic fire engines and two vintage ambulances which will be manned by Volunteer Fire Service members collecting donations for the Victorian Bush Fires Appeal.

Whiteman Park manager Steve Lowe said that the Classic Car Show was a great free event which continued to grow from strength to strength.

"The Classic Car Show is the biggest outdoor classic vehicle display in the state and always draws much interest," Mr Lowe said.

"This year there will be plenty of free entertainment including children's activities, arts and crafts, fortune tellers and of course numerous food stalls.

"Car clubs will also be constructing interesting displays themed towards their club and vehicles with prizes awarded for the best dressed costumes to match the vehicle."

The Classic Car Show will be held on 15 March 2009 at Mussel Pool, Whiteman Park from 10am to 4pm.

The Western Australian Motor Museum at Whiteman Park houses an extensive collection of automobile artefacts ranging from very early model cars to high performance machines. The museum is open 7 days a week from 10am to 4pm.
