

VILLAGE TREE TRAIL

There are just 22 tree species naturally occurring within the boundaries of Whiteman Park.

Excitingly, by following the path network you can see 15 of these trees here in the Village! Growing from 6-40 metres or more, they form the canopy of the Park's bushland and damplands.

Take a stroll around the Village to learn about these trees and why we love them. The full loop is a gentle 2km walk.

Hint: scan the QR code at each stop to learn more about that species.








