the Children's Forest.



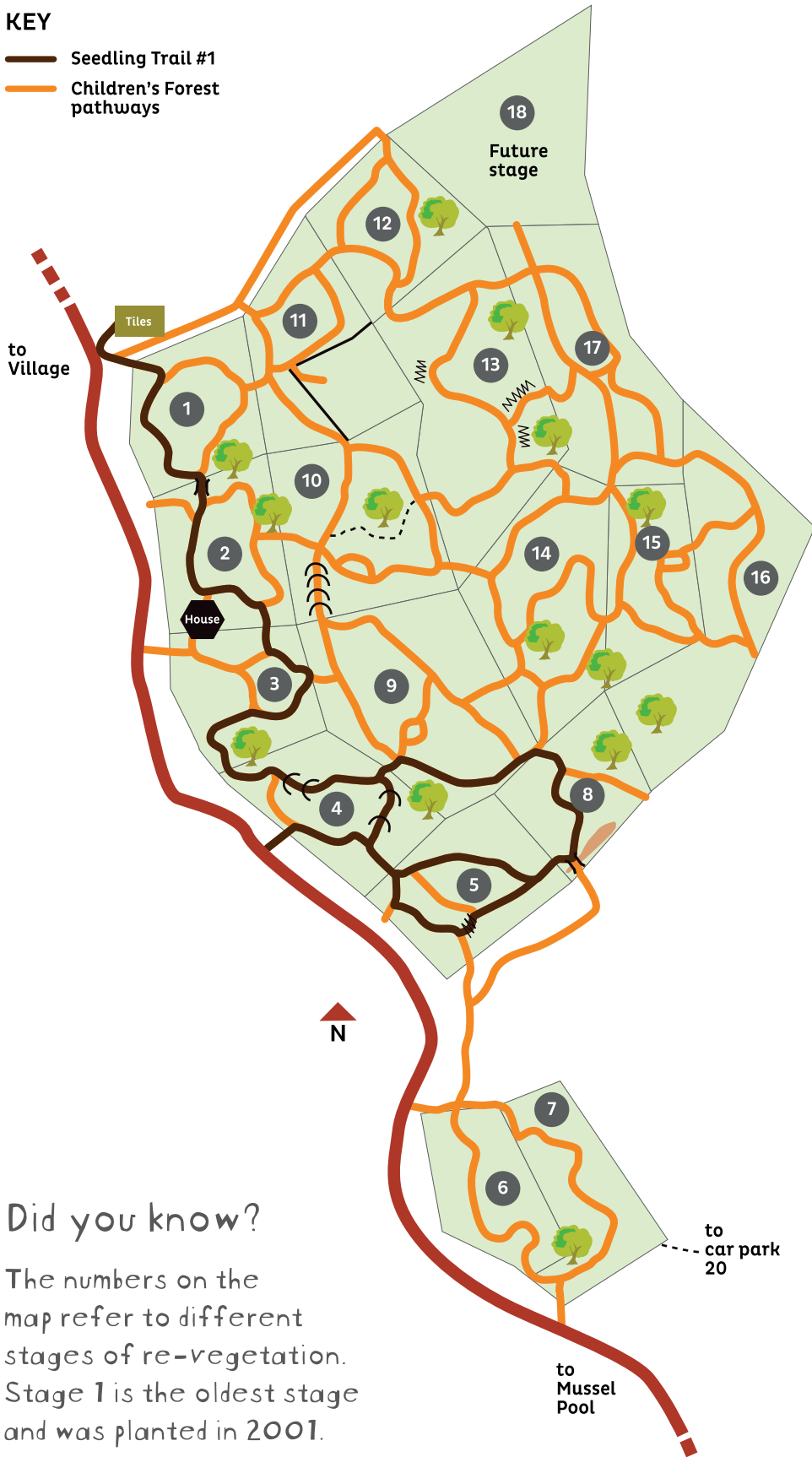
7. There are seasons in the Aboriginal Noongar calendar.
